The City of Ashland is continuing efforts to combat the damage and needs from the Winter Storms.

The Mayor and Commissioners are working in coordinating with the Ashland-Boyd Co-Catlettsburg Office of Emergency Management (Lead Agency) to provide some relief from the cold for those burdened by the outage.

Salvation Army in Ashland is operating on a 24/7 basis during this outage for the homeless population to find relief from the cold. 2212 Carter Avenue Ashland, KY 606-329-2874.

The Boyd County Convention Center located at 15605 State Route 180 Catlettsburg, KY 41129 is also open on a 24/7 basis as a warming center for residents without power. It has tables and chairs during the day and cots available at night. This center is equipped to handle the emergency efficiently with restroom facilities, back up generator, and space to allow for proper social distancing.

If you need transportation to the Convention Center, the Ashland Bus System is operating a paratransit service from 8am-9pm on a circumstantial call-in basis. Please call 606-393-1801, 606-393-1842, or 606-385-3220 to assess your transportation needs.
