2021 - 2022 Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG)**

The City of Ashland, (the City) anticipates receiving Federal funding from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) to implement service projects that benefit low and moderate-income persons. The City anticipates to receive approximately \$573,795 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for Federal Program Year 2021, which encompasses the period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.
